Welcome between 09:00-09:20 on 4 to 6 tables Collective warm-up, led by a coach from the host club at 09:35 Start of the U15 competition at 10:00 U15s scheduled to finish at 13:00 **U18** Welcome between 13:00-13:50 on 4 to 6 tables Start of U18 competition at 14:15 U18s scheduled to finish at 17:30

#### **Competition system**

U15: 3'00" fights (+ Golden Score if required) U18: 4'00" fights (+ Golden Score if required).

#### Grouped by equivalent weight.

**Pools of 4** (6 fights per pool). Pools of 3 or pools of 2 (best of 3) may be proposed. For the final ranking, we will take into account the number of victories, then the number of points, and finally the direct confrontation.

All the judokas will be called to the different tables at the same time and they will wait next to the table.

In the interests of learning, the judokas will wait until the end of their pool.

#### **Refereeing**

Club coaches are responsible for refereeing. Each participating club is asked to appoint 1 coach who will also act as referee and sports commissioner.

Dress for referees (all): black trousers (whatever the type of fabric) and white T-shirt. The refereeing rules are those of Luxembourg (see attached document).

#### **Awards**

1st prize: Gold medal 2nd prize: Silver medal 3rd prize: Bronze medal
